## **A MAJOR NEW TOURIST ATTRACTION IS COMING TO ARLINGTON** **Enhancing the cultural dimension of the tourist model.**

Announcing the formation of a non-profit organization that will bring a new element to the cultural horizon of Arlington, Texas. It is the Arlington Museum of Information Technology, or AMIT. The directors of AMIT intend to develop a major additional tourist attraction in Arlington.

Capitalizing on a collection of artifacts from the last century of the field of information processing, AMIT will present them to the public in well researched, informative displays, thereby increasing public awareness and understanding of the history of this field in general and specifically the role of Texas and Texans in this history.

Arlington is an ideal spot for this new museum because of its central location in the DFW Metroplex and its existing commitment to the tourism industry.

A phased development plan calls for immediate location of display cases in existing facilities around Arlington. Interested parties are invited to contact AMIT about placing a display in their facility. Later phases of the program call for increasingly larger facilities where complete exhibits can be shown. These exhibits will enable visits by large groups, including students from the Arlington Independent School District, The University of Texas Arlington and Tarrant County College, among others.

AMIT is chartered by the State of Texas and is recognized by the IRS as a non-profit scientific and educational organization under section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code.
